#### 1.0 Purpose

All students who plan to park on campus are required to purchase a valid parking permit. A permit is not required for students parking at CCS facilities located off the main campuses of SCC and SFCC.

## 2.0 Limitations and Requirements

- 2.1 A valid student virtual parking permit is required for student parking on the SCC and SFCC campuses.
- 2.2 The fee for the virtual parking permit is established by the board of trustees of Community Colleges of Spokane.
- 2.3 Virtual parking permit are subject to State of Washington retail sales tax according to RCW 82.04.050(3d).
- 2.4 Anyone parking on campus must have a valid virtual parking permit or park at a paid meter.

## 3.0 Virtual Parking Permit

- 3.1 Students may purchase a day, month, quarterly, annual virtual parking permit from their online parking account or college cashier's office upon payment of the permit fee as published in the Schedule of Parking Fees and Fines.
- 3.2 The virtual parking permit fee is nonrefundable. Individual cases may be reviewed by the Director of Security.

# 4.0 Parking Regulations

- **4.1** The student is responsible to maintain current and accurate vehicle information in their parking account.
- 4.2 Students must park in designated student spaces.
- 4.3 Violators are subject to fines and other measures as described in WAC 132Q-20-260.
